

THE PORTRAIT PROCESS

Creativity and collaboration, a power-packed duo that includes the artist and the client...from the beginning stages of consultation to the final stages of satisfaction, the steps are these:

1. Initial consultation for ambience, colors, setting, mood, background, choice of clothes
2. securing the portrait with down payment.
3. Multiple photographs with Rebel XTI in studio or in a setting of your choice.
4. Reviewing the photographs and choosing the size, style and general composition.
5. Review of drawing stage for likeness.
6. Choosing a frame for archival quality.
7. Client brought in at several intermediary stages for inclusion of suggestions.
8. Final sitting in the studio for any image refinement.
9. Final payment and delivery.

PORTRAIT FEES

Portraits are priced based upon individual requirements, set at the initial consult. Fees begin at

- * \$1000 for a single-subject, head-and-shoulders portrait, with price increases for portrait-like inclusions of jewelry, medals, fancy collars, animals or any other objects of complexity in fore- or background
- * \$1400 for half-figure (extras, refer above)
- * \$1600 for three-quarter figure (extras, above)
- * \$1800 for full figure (extras, above)
- * \$3500 for life-size children's portrait, 3' x 4'
- * + for life-size adult, after consultation

A discount of 25% is allowed for multiple figures in same portrait.

A down payment of 50 % is required upon beginning the portrait, which secures its place in line and is non-refundable.

Fees do not include framing, applicable sales taxes, or travel and shipping expenses. Preliminary costs, such as travel, are billed when incurred.

The balance is due upon final approval and acceptance of the portrait within a reasonable time frame from notification, of approximately two weeks. If for any reason you as the customer are not entirely satisfied, and I am unable with my best efforts to satisfy you, there will be no final payment. Please contact Joanna for further information.
